

## Subject: Air Conditioning - BSI issues qualifications update

BSI has issued an update reference Air Conditioning Qualifications, as follows:

Any current air conditioning qualifications that meet the requirements of EU Regulation 842/2006 and European Commission Regulation 307/2008 held by staff will be recognised.



**With immediate effect Certificates issued for air conditioning qualifications by the City and Guilds, IMI and other organisations for the above qualifications will be deemed as current until there are any legislative requirement changes issued by DEFRA and therefore do not have an expiry date.**

Air conditioning qualifications that were gained during ATA qualifications in MET will expire at the same as the ATA qualification expires, contact the IMI regarding updates for this qualification.

Additional to these qualifications it is expected that clients will have evidence of any additional training with regards to MAC on Hybrid/EV vehicles and for any new equipment in use i.e. for the gassing and de-gassing of HFO 1234yf systems.

The Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (DEFRA) issues guidance for the [Mobile Air Conditioning](#) (MAC) sectors. Information sheets MAC 1 to MAC 5 refer.

DEFRA document MAC 5 identifies awarding bodies that offer courses/qualifications within this discipline.
